Dear Friends

This is our thirteenth update from the island - and for those of us living here, life is swiftly returning to normal.

My wife, Rachel, returning from the UK, has just had had her second Coronavirus test, which was also negative thus allowing us to venture out to enjoy some of the shops and restaurants. Most establishments are fully open and there are no requirements to wear a mask, although many employees do; but you are encouraged to use hand sanitizer. The social distancing is now set at one metre ... but there is little evidence of that in many of the island's thriving bars, which are swiftly regaining their lively, tropical atmosphere.

The big news for the island is the announcement by the Collectivity that, from 22nd June, "family members and residents, home-owners, or simply lovers of our island wishing to spend a few days here ... St Barts welcomes you"! The entry rule requires you to have a negative Covid-19 test 72 hours before arrival, or you can test within 24 hours of your arrival, confining yourself until the result of that test is known; and then a second follow up test is needed if your stay is longer than 7 days. It is not known what the French State thinks about this 'home-made' rule.

Our opening video this week is a short 'infomercial' which will help promote our virtual Sunday Service to a wider audience – we hope you like it. This Sunday we have the Rev'd Barbara Robinson preaching, who has visited St Barts several times, mostly during November. She hails from Ontario, Canada, hence the slight Canadian feel to our service this week, with La Chorale's version of Hallelujah by Canada's favourite songwriter Leonard Cohen and the final song is our favourite: The Blessing ... this time sung by churches across Canada. Remember, as it says in the lyrics: "He is for You!" Rev'd Barbara will be online with us for our usual Zoom coffee hour at 10am Sunday (see details below), and it might be fun to share any memories/stories we have about Canada!

We received some very sad news this past week, which was the passing of Lucy Day. Nat and Lucy Day have had a long connection with the island and have been great supporters of our Church. Lucy's positive energy and enthusiasm-will be missed greatly. We will dedicate this coming Tuesday's virtual Taizé service to Lucy, and we will also have a special memorial service in the Church at a later date.

While we still struggle with how best to act with the spectre of the Coronavirus

still over us; we should also think of all those people who are peacefully protesting about the death of George Floyd, and how best to include everyone in our society. We continue to hold in our prayers all of those who are suffering at this difficult time. Let's continue to Stay Safe ...
